



## **PUBLIC STATEMENT**

Talcahuano, 01 October 2020 14.30pm

1. Camanchaca reports that the fire affecting, since this morning, the facilities of the frozen jack mackerel plant of the Fishing division in Talcahuano, is still in combat phase with the support of 15 fire companies of the Gran Concepcion.
2. The company informs that there is no clarity yet on the causes that started the fire, but the important thing is that the fire has not caused any damage to the people who were there.
3. The plant was not operating since July, when the jack mackerel season ended. Therefore, there were only a limited number of people who were able to evacuate the facilities without problems.
4. So far there is no clarity of the degree of impact to the Company of this productive unit. Camanchaca's technical and human teams are deployed on site to coordinate and collaborate with the work of firefighters and emergency teams to avoid further damage.
5. The official information provided to our company by the Talcahuano Fire Department Command coordinating the extinguishing efforts has indicated that there has been no release into the atmosphere of any kind of gases or chemicals use in the production , and that ammonia and oil tanks are out of danger.
6. Currently, efforts are aimed at preventing the spread of the fire and once the emergency has been overcome in the coming hours, the investigation of the causes will begin, which preliminary is considered accidental during improvement and maintenance work.
7. There is no indication so far that the fire may affect other adjacent production areas, or nearby individuals or residences.
8. Camanchaca's facilities have building insurance, construction, contents, and damages for business interruption, all of which have been activated.
