**Other eligible fishers (or other entities that may share the certificate as new client group members)**

Other eligible fishers are defined as Chilean industrial purse seiners licensed to fish Chilean jack mackerel in regions III-X and XIV and international waters that are not members of SONAPESCA.

**Points of landing or other transfer and other limits to product eligibility**

The scope of this certification ends at the points of landing. Downstream certification of the product will require appropriate certification of storage and handling facilities at these locations.

In order for subsequent links in the distribution chain to be able to use the MSC logo, jack mackerel products must enter into a separate chain of custody certification from the point of landing forward. The subsequent links must be able to prove that they can trace jack mackerel products back to the permitted vessels which landed the product.

The main points of landing for this fishery are all major Chilean ports.
